

China Foreign Policy:

This course covers China's Foreign Policy in four segments. First the Foundations of China's Foreign Policy and its linkages with domestic politics, history and the party's centrality to China. The Second segment focuses on the methods and approaches of Chinese foreign policy, including the specifics of vocabulary. The third part looks at China's relations with major powers including the dynamic triangular and quadrangular relations. The fourth part will specifically cover China's relations with South Asia including India China relations. In all these segments, China's rise and its self-perception and its ideas of Asian and Global orders will be the central themes. Assessment will include 2 short essays based on text analysis and oped. 1 book review and one final exam. Assessment details may change based on class composition and interest and workload management.
